In the Bronx, the City would build a modern facility at the existing tow pound at 320 Concord Avenue. The new jail would have housing units for detainees, and programming and recreational space. The western portion of the site could be rezoned to a special mixed-use district to allow the development of a mixed-use building in the future.
